## SERMON SUMMARY: GO TELL IT ON THE MOUNTAIN

Sin is a serious matter before God. It is not just a minor mistake or a simple misstep. It is a barrier that separates us from God's presence and blessings. As Ephesians 2:12 reminds us, sin aligns us with the same fate as Satan. This separation is profound.

The good news - the Gospel - is that Jesus Christ has delivered us from the wrath to come (Romans 5:9; 1 Thessalonians 1:10). Through His sacrifice, we are offered forgiveness, reconciliation, and a new destiny. But this good news is not meant to be kept to ourselves; Jesus calls us to share it with everyone, everywhere.

#### **Empowered to Witness**

One of the primary reasons we are baptised with the Holy Spirit is to receive power to be witnesses for Christ (Acts 1:8). The Holy Spirit equips and emboldens us to testify about God's goodness, both in our words and actions. As we openly share what God has done in our lives, we glorify Him and position ourselves to experience even more of His blessings. God delights in giving us daily opportunities to share His love and faithfulness with others.

Our very existence as believers is to be Christ's witnesses reflecting His light in our speech, actions, and lifestyles. We are called to be living testimonies of His grace and power.

#### True Worship: More Than a Song

Being a true worshipper of God goes far beyond singing songs of praise. True worship is about living a life honouring and glorifying God in every aspect. Our daily conduct should reflect the character and love of Jesus, serving as a powerful witness to those around us.

As true worshippers, we are assured of Christ's covering and advocacy, as Jesus Himself said in Matthew 10:32-33.Living What We Believe

It is not enough to merely profess faith; we must practice it. Our beliefs must be evident in our actions. As James teaches, faith without works is dead (James 3:17,26). God's promises are inherited by those who not only believe but also act in accordance with that belief. We are called to be doers of the Word, not hearers only.

#### Evangelism: The Pinnacle of Spiritual Warfare

The greatest form of spiritual warfare is evangelism – proclaiming the Gospel. The battle for souls is at the heart of spiritual conflict. We must be committed to winning souls if we truly desire to see our prayers answered and God's kingdom advanced. The Gospel is the power of God unto salvation (Romans 1:16), and it is through the Word that lives are transformed.

Isaiah 52:7 beautifully captures this calling: "How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, 'Your God reigns!"

The call to "go tell it on the mountain" is a call to every believer. We are entrusted with the greatest message ever told – the message of salvation through Jesus Christ. Let us not keep this good news to ourselves. Instead, let us live lives that reflect God's love, speak boldly of His goodness, and actively seek opportunities to share the Gospel.

Additional Scriptures for Reflection - Mark 16:1-8 – The resurrection and the command to go and tell. - Luke 15:7 – The joy in heaven over one sinner who repents. - Luke 12:8-9 – The importance of acknowledging Christ before

others - Matthew 5:14-16 - Letting our light shine before men.

#### MIDWEEK SERVICE: THE FREEDOM CHARTER

In Christ, we have freedom-freedom from the bondage of sin (Galatians 5:1). However, it is possible to return to bondage if we don't stand fast to the freedom we have in Christ.

The gospel of Christ isn't just the power of God that brings Salvation (Romans 1:16), it brings blessings. When Adam sinned, two things happened: his sin brought death, that is, separation from God and curses (Genesis 3:17-19). The curse is manifested in 3 ways: 1. Spiritual death, which is separation from God. 2. Sickness. 3. Poverty.

There are four reasons why we are not living in the fullness of the blessing that comes with the gospel of Christ.

- Self-righteousness: (Galatians 3:8, Isaiah 64:6, Luke 18:10-14).
- Carnality: This is seen in spiritual babes. The signs that one is carnal/a babe are: a) Selfishness, b) Unreliable, c) Easily distracted, d) Worldliness.
- Hyper spirituality: In Christ, it is the first transformation of life before the manifestation of power. (1 Corinthians 1:4-5)
- Heresy: Teachings contrary to the doctrine of Christ. (2 Peter 2:1-12)


