SERMON SUMMARY: THE GOSPEL OF GRACE

The gospel is profoundly important because it is the means through which salvation and blessings come to everyone who believes (Galatians 3:8). Grace means trusting solely in Christ, that what He has done is entirely sufficient. John 1:15-16 reveals that grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. If we lack grace, we can receive it, but only from Jesus.

It's important to understand that truth is different from mere facts. For example, at the start of a new day, the fact may be that it is still dark, but the truth is that the day has begun.

Grace often shows itself in the things we do with ease. To discover your area of grace, reflect on what you do easily that others struggle with. That area is where God will manifest His power through you.

The Christian life is a life of grace, and we must cherish it. This is why we should live continually in thanksgiving (Ephesians 2:4, 1 Thessalonians 5:18). Thanksgiving is the only fitting response to God's grace because we have done nothing to earn it – He freely chose to give it to us.

What God can do, His Word of grace can also accomplish (Acts 20:32). God's Word of grace builds us up before we receive the inheritance He promises. We cannot receive our inheritance until His Word builds us up. We accept it when taught God's pure and undiluted Word. Inheritance varies for each person, but if we remain spiritually immature, we won't receive it (Galatians 4:1-2). We must focus on becoming, not just having. Let's fast and pray to become instead of fasting and praying to have.

Grace and truth came through Jesus (John 1:17). Truth purifies, while grace builds up. Both are essential. Grace without truth leads to damage, and truth without grace leaves us without evidence of God's favour.

We must never forget the law of seedtime and harvest (Genesis 8:22).

There are different kinds of seeds:

- The Word seed: which is the most important (Luke 8:11). It is wise to ask God for both food and seed (2 Corinthians 9:10). As we sow, crops grow (Isaiah 55:10). To receive what we need, we must find God's Word concerning it and sow on the right soil (Hosea 10:12).
- The seed of our deeds: (Galatians 6:7-9). Whatever we do, good or bad, returns to us (Jeremiah 17:11). Therefore, we must not grow weary in doing good, for in due time, we will reap a reward.
- Money Seed: where your treasure is, there your heart will be. When we engage the covenant of tithing and other sacrificial types of giving, we are sowing. And we shall surely reap. In all that God gives, there is seed and there is food. No farmer eats food and seed. They sow the seed so that they can have continuous harvest. It is so also with our money. When we give our tithes, we sowing our seeds for the future. Those who eat their seed do not have a future. God gives food to the eater and seed to the sower. Eat the food, but also sow the seed.

HOLY COMMUNION SERVICE - THE GRACE OF GOD

The grace of God is an invisible and intangible spiritual substance. Although we cannot physically see or touch it, we can clearly recognise where and when it is at work in our lives.

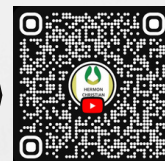
There are several ways we can receive grace or ways through which grace can be transferred. They are:

1. **By Association:** (1 Corinthians 15:33, Proverbs 13:20). Your association determines your fortune.
2. **By Laying on of Hands:** (Deuteronomy 34:6-9, 2 Timothy 1:6). If we don't honour the person who lays hands on us, we'll not be imparted by his/her grace.
3. **By the Clothing of the Anointed:** (Psalm 133:2, Mark 5:25-29, Acts 19:11-12).
4. **Through words:** (Matthew 8:8). The preaching of the Word of grace imparts grace to the hearers.
5. **Through the Holy Communion:** (John 6:53-58, Galatians 3:13-14, 2 Corinthians 12:9, Matthew 11:29).

Regardless of how we seek to receive grace, two things are essential to receive: a pure heart and faith. (2 Peter 2:1-2)

DAILY DEVOTIONAL

Praise is powerful, especially when it is done with understanding. It will always work in all situations. You can pray amiss, but you can never praise amiss. "You ask, and receive not, because you ask amiss, that you may consume it upon your lusts." (James 4:3). To ask amiss is to ask wrongly, that is, to ask what is outside the will of God.

This is, in fact, one of the reasons we do not get results when we pray. We ask according to our lusts or for selfish reasons. God grants desires, but we must first delight ourselves in Him. "Delight yourself also in the LORD; and He shall give you the desires of your heart." (Psalm 37:4).

One of the ways to delight yourself in the LORD is when you praise Him—oftentimes, our prayers centre on our needs and desires, only about us. But praise is all about God. You can't genuinely praise God and focus on yourself. True praise focuses on God alone. It extols God for who He is. You are right at the centre of His will whenever you praise God this way.
