### Day 4

#### **06:00** Prayer Watch

##### **Bible Reading: Psalm 29:1-11**

1. Declare and praise the greatness of God. Call Him by His mighty and glorious names. Ascribe glory to Him. (Psalm 68:32-35).
2. God is the God of peace and He promised in His word to give us peace by all means. (2 Thessalonians 3:16). Ask God to give you peace by all means, on every side.
3. Pray for peace in the nations, starting with our nation, Nigeria (1 Timothy 2:1-4) and the nation of Israel. (Psalm 122:6).

#### **09:00** Prayer Watch

##### **Bible Reading: Philippians 1:3-11**

1. Exploits and greater works are products of great faith. Faith begins where the will of God is known. Pray that you will be filled with the knowledge of the will of God in all wisdom and spiritual understanding. (Colossians 1:9).
2. Pray that as a church and as individuals, we all may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God. (Philippians 4:12).
3. Pray that as a church and as individuals, we may walk worthy of God unto all pleasing in all things. (Colossians 1:10).

#### **12:00** Prayer Watch

##### **Bible Reading: Isaiah 2:1-5**

1. Thank God for adding to our church daily. Pray that Christ may dwell in the heart of all new converts and members, and that each of them be rooted and grounded in love. (Ephesians 3:17).
2. Pray that the weakest among us shall be mighty like David and that in our church, HERMON, Zechariah 12:8 finds expression and fulfillment.
3. Pray that as we walk in the light of the LORD, God will cause a mighty harvest into our church and continually be a wall of fire around us. (Zechariah 2:4-5).

#### **03:00** Prayer Watch

##### **Bible Reading: Psalm 27:1-9**

1. Ask God to shine forth for you and reveal His glory in your life this 2nd half of the year. (Psalm 80:1).
2. Ask God to bring you out of every obscurity and cause His light to shine on you. (Isaiah 60:1-3).
3. Pray that as we gather to pray together by 6pm this evening, whatever that has defied your prayers shall bow to the corporate faith and anointing as written in Leviticus 26:8.
