# SERMON SUMMARY: THE PRAYER OF FAITH

Faith works in two ways: we believe what God has said, and then we take corresponding action. Faith that moves mountains begins with a revelation of God, which can only be gained as you grow in your knowledge of God. Daniel 11:32 states that it is those who know their God that will be strong and do exploits.

Just as in sports, different rules govern various sports; similarly, there are different kinds of prayers, each with its own principles that govern it. For the prayer of faith to work, we must first of all know God's will. The prayer of faith can only be effective when God's will is clearly known. Knowing the will of God is crucial because it reveals what God wants for us in that situation (Mark 11:22-24).

Another thing we must know about faith is that it must be built; that is, we must exercise our faith to grow it. We can't believe God for millions when we haven't exercised faith in God to get thousands.

**First, there are 3 kinds of faith:**

1. The Saving Faith (Ephesians 2:8-9). This is the faith through which we receive salvation.
2. The Living Faith (Romans 12:3). This is the measure of faith we are given after salvation. It is our responsibility to increase this kind of faith (2 Thessalonians 1:3).
3. The Gift of Faith (1 Corinthians 12:7). The discretion of the Holy Spirit gives this. He gives it to whoever He chooses.

When we pray the prayer of faith, we must first receive by faith what we have asked for, and then we will have it physically. Until we have first received by faith, we cannot have what we pray for. It's like when we get born again. Nothing about our physical appearance changes when we do, but we have an assurance within us that something has happened.

When we start to ask God again for what we prayed for, we have cancelled the first prayer. We will not receive what we prayed for. After we pray, we should instead begin to thank God for answering while we await the physical manifestation.

That's how the prayer of faith works. You don't need to feel anything to know that your prayer has been answered. Faith is not based on feelings.

Now there are different categories of confession.

- First is the confession that brings salvation (Romans 10:9).
- The second is the confession of sins (1 John 1:9, Proverbs 23:13).
- The third category of confession is the confession of faith (2 Corinthians 4:13, Psalm 116:10). This third category of faith is what we do in between the time we receive what we ask for when we pray the prayer of faith and when we're waiting for the manifestation of what we receive in prayer.

Why must we confess in faith? There are four reasons: It is the way the God-kind of faith works (Mark 11:14). It is the only thing that will sustain and build up our faith (Joshua 1:2,6-9).

It is the way we build the track upon which the cargo of faith comes.

It is the way we put God in remembrance of what we prayed for and received (Isaiah 43:26).

We must learn to claim what we receive in prayer by faith. It is only when we do this that we will see the manifestation of what we have prayed for.

**There are four ways in which our confession of faith will work:**

1. We must be saying the same thing as God. This means we must be praying His will.
2. We must be claiming what Jesus has done for us.
3. We must be creating what we received by faith.
4. We must be commanding and decreeing

The Holy Spirit will direct us on which way to confess our faith each time.

## DELIVERED FROM FATAL WORKPLACE ACCIDENT

I joined the monthly fasting and prayer which was for three days. I was really determined and made sure I also joined the Congregational Prayer Service every evening by 6pm.

On the third and last day of the fast, I was so famished at work that I decided to take a break from work to rest. I saw two guys resting under a shaded area and joined them to take shelter from the scorching sun.

I laid on my stomach and slept off. The next thing was that I felt a thud on my head. A nine-inches block fell off the head of the laborer carrying it and landed at the back of my head! The pain was excruciating. I jumped up from sleep and held the back of my head thinking that the worst had happened. The guy, whom the block slipped from his head, rushed down shouting and crying, believing he had either killed someone or caused a fatal injury to someone's head.

But to the glory of God, nothing, not even a single drop of blood came out of my body or head. There was also no swelling and the pain subsided and left completely later that day.

I am thanking God for several reasons. Number one is that if I was lying on my back, the block would have landed on my face and that would have crushed my face. Number two, the guy was carrying two of those nine-inches block but only one fell on me. Number three, the block that fell on me did not hurt or harm me. Number four, all the aches and pains left me that day and I have been feeling fine ever since.

I thank God for preserving my life from what would have been a fatal accident that would left me paralyzed, maimed or dead. I return to give God all the glory.

### Principle 4 - Compatibility

The fifth principle is compatibility.

It is important to that you flow with your intending spouse. Compatibility means to fit each other like a glove fits the hand.

In biblical terms, it means to be equally yoked. It is not just that the person is born again only. There should be a match in other terms - spiritually, mentally, socially, psychologically, etc.

In my experience, I have seen people who are born again but don't fit in other terms. Nothing is wrong with them but they are wrong for each other as it concerns marriage even though they are believers.

This is where you need discernment, counsel and help from the Holy Spirit and your spiritual leaders. You may be already too excited or emotional to judge things objectively. Emotions blur objectivity. They make us biased against truthful reality.

But it is important to note that not all gloves that fit your hand is yours. There are many metrics that can help you to choose. For example, that you flowed with someone you sat by in a flight or a bus ride does not mean you are compatible. Someone can flow with you in certain social situations but be completely misaligned as it concerns your whole personality and future.

David was flowing with the Philistines during his exile years from Israel as a result of king Saul's hatred. But it does not mean that his destiny was compatible with the Philistines. They were far apart.

There are many examples I can give but my counsel is to led by the Holy Spirit and to seek godly counsel before committing to a marriage partner.
