This is why God cried out in Hosea 4:6 that His people are being destroyed by lack of knowledge. More so, you will not enjoy the grace of God unless you grow in knowledge. The more you grow in the true knowledge of God, the more you will enjoy the grace of God.

Read your Bible daily, listen to sermons again and again. That's how you grow in grace.

SERMON SUMMARIES

1ST SERVICE: - IN MY FATHER'S HOUSE

The Church is not a place to do business or where you come to get connections. It's a place to worship God. The true temple of God is your body, not the building. You are the true temple of God. When we come to Church, we are the temples of God gathered together.

"In my Father's house there are many mansions" refers to man's spirit. You are a spirit being. The Holy Spirit lives in your body, the temple, and he dwells in your spirit.

The Old Testament temple that Moses built had three parts: the outer court, the inner court and the Holy of Holies. Moses' temple was a depiction of the temple of the New Testament. The outer court stands for your physical body. The inner court for your soul, and the place the High Priest enters once a year with blood, represents your spirit. The only light in the Holy of Holies is the Glory of God. In the same way, in your spirit, you don't live by the outer lights but by the Spirit of God.

This means that once we are born again, our spirit is the house—the dwelling place of the Holy Spirit. Therefore, the house Jesus mentioned is us. He did not merely speak of a physical structure but more of the people who become born again.

How to Build Mansions In Your Spirit - Jude 1 vs 20.

When we speak in tongues, we are building up something in the spirit realm. Pray an hour in tongues every day. Speaking in Tongues is our spiritual advantage. If you want mansions in your life, if you want advancement in your life,

2ND SERVICE: IN MY FATHER'S HOUSE (Part 2)

If the Holy Spirit lives in you, you are God's House. You are the address of God on earth, and there are implications of being God's House

- You can't use your body anyhow. (2 Corinthians 6:14). Your body is not your own when you become Born Again. Even the way you eat should change. God does not dwell in unclean vessels. Holiness means something that is not common. It means separated to God. It's a consciousness that you can't be like others because you carry God. You can't behave like everyone else, or dress the way they dress (Exodus 2:15-17). You may be born again, but how you dress can classify you.
- If you consistently watch things that make your confession wrong, you should not watch those things. Everything you watch goes into your spirit, where the Holy Spirit lives, and when He sees those things, He will be grieved and stay silent.
- When you live with the consciousness that you are God's temple, you will not be the stomping ground for strangers. God places a hedge of protection around you. (Job 1:10). Certain things should not happen around you when you are the dwelling place of God.

When you are separated unto God, you are His dwelling place, people will not take you for granted. Daniel 5 vs 1-30. God Himself will arise and fight your battles when you live for Him.

MIDWEEK SERVICE: - HOW TO KNOW WHEN GOD IS SPEAKING TO YOU

The Word of God is what makes our spirit man strong. We feed our souls by reading and hearing the Word of God. Divine communication takes place in our spirit being. God speaks to us in the innermost part of our being, which is our spirit man. God is always speaking. {(Psalm 135:15-17). The 1st characteristic of God is that he speaks.

7 WAYS GOD SPEAKS TO US IN OUR SPIRITS

1. By Inward Witness: (Romans 8:15, 1 John 5:10).
2. Through our Thoughts: (Isaiah 55:8-9, Jeremiah 29:11, Job 4:12-13, Micah 4:12).
3. Through Dreams & Visions. (Acts 16:6-10).
4. By impressions: Spiritual impression is having complete and perfect knowledge about a thing without a conscious thought.
5. By Spiritual Perception: (Hebrews 5:12-14).
6. By a still, small voice. 1 Kings 19 vs 10 - 13.
7. Through Silence: 1 Samuel 28:3-6).

If you are not quiet within and outside, you will not hear the still, small voice. Study to be quiet.

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DAILY DEVOTIONAL

God introduced Himself to Moses as I AM THAT I AM. "And God said to Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and He said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you." (Exodus 3:14). This was God's response to Moses asking Him who he should tell the children of Israel had sent him to them during the encounter of the burning bush.

This powerful name of God has never been known before. Earlier, God had revealed Himself to the fathers by other names. For example, in one of His encounters with Abraham, the father of the nation, in Genesis 17:1, God revealed Himself to Abraham as EL SHADDAI. The name, EL SHADDAI, means the ALMIGHTY, THE MOST POWERFUL.

God had to introduce Himself this way to Abraham because of what He wanted Abraham to do. Here, He was about to change the names of Abram and Sarai to Abraham and Sarah. Abraham means 'the father of many nations.' At that time, Abraham was 99 years old and Sarah was 89 years old.

Yet even at their advanced years, God was still promising them a son because He is the ALMIGHTY. And they eventually had that son, Isaac, even in old age. (Hebrews 11:11-12).
