SERMON SUMMARIES

1ST SERVICE: THE SPIRITUAL DIMENSION OF WEALTH (Part 1)

True, sustainable wealth is not merely material accumulation but is secured through a covenant relationship with God, which requires a foundation of righteousness and upright character. God is the owner and the exclusive benevolent source of riches without sorrow.

There are many ways that you can get rich. Here are four

1. Hard Work: You can get rich by working diligently.
2. Gift or Inheritance: You can become rich through innate talent or inherited assets.

Satan: This source has terrible side effects and consequences.

4. God: This is the best way and the only source of riches that "adds no sorrow with it."

Job did not just have riches (material possessions); he had wealth, which was his relationship with God (Job 1:1, 1:8). This relationship, rooted in being blameless and upright (righteous), was his hedge of protection against Satan.

Two spiritual qualities define the key to accessing God's wealth

• Righteousness is a Gift: This is the gift that God provides through salvation.

Uprightness is a Decision: This is the conscious

decision we make daily on how to live our lives. Many are saved (have the gift of righteousness) but fail to live righteously (by deciding to be upright). His character of uprightness first described Job.

A person's character is their main inheritance and true riches. If the first thing you notice about someone is their affluence, your value system is flawed.

The real thing to pass on to your children is your covenant with God and your example of living uprightly (referencing God choosing Abraham because he would command his children to follow God).

Since "The earth is the Lord's, and the fullness thereof" (Psalm 24:1; Haggai 2:8), God will relate to humanity concerning wealth only based on a covenant—an irrevocable agreement with well-defined terms.

To receive wealth from God, you must first possess the right mindset, which acknowledges divine ownership (Psalm 24:1-2; Haggai 2:8).

Divine Ownership: You must have the mindset that 'the earth is the Lord's and the fullness of it belongs to

him." God did not just create everything; He owns everything (Psalm 50:7-14).

Covenant Requirement: God always deals with humanity based on a covenant—an irrevocable agreement with well-defined terms. If you want God's wealth, you must understand His covenant for wealth and start living it.

There are two components necessary for receiving and maintaining covenant wealth (Deuteronomy 8:11-18):

The Principles (Systems to Guard Against Forgetting God): When God makes you rich, you must put systems in place to prevent your heart from being "lifted up" and forgetting Him. This is the danger that cost Nebuchadnezzar his kingdom.

Non-Negotiables: Tithing and coming to Church are examples of foundational systems and red lines you

can't cross that keep your focus on God.

Avoid Arrogance: It is a sin to forget that it is God who blessed you and gave you the power to get wealth. Never forget the people God used to bless you; do not use them as "doormats or steps."

The Power (God's Provision): The power to get wealth flows directly from the covenant.

God's Provision: God may not give you cash directly, but He gives you the power—the wisdom, the idea, the connections, the strength to work, and favour.

Holiness and Consecration: The ultimate covenant is being born again. The more you live holily, the more this power increases, while sin "eats away your glory."

The Establishment: God gives wealth to establish His covenant. There must be an establishment (the consecrated life) before the manifestation (the material wealth). Your salvation is your greatest asset; don't lose it.

2ND SERVICE: THE SPIRITUAL DIMENSION OF WEALTH: (Part 2)

True wealth is secured in the spirit realm first. Maintaining this wealth requires active spiritual preparedness, vigilance against sin, and an understanding that ideas, wisdom, and character are the highest form of capital, far superior to

If the blessing is not obtained spiritually, it is not truly obtained. While the reality of people engaging in rituals for money (Satan's wealth) is acknowledged, it is firmly established that the Devil's wealth always comes with a price. Only God's wealth "has no sorrow with it."

Spiritual growth involves training, which prepares believers for the inevitable temptations that accompany success Believing God is and breakthroughs.

The Holy Spirit's Guide: The Holy Spirit guides you to places of training, which may include things you dislike or challenges you must overcome.

Divine Preparation: Crucially, God will not allow you to be tested or tempted in areas for which you have not been trained (Hebrews 2:1).

Sermons as Foresight: If you face a test you feel unprepared for, it is because you ignored the training. Sermons are presented as "exposés" or advance warnings that God gives to prepare you ahead of future tests.

Here is practical guidance on battling temptation, which is key to protecting one's spiritual and, subsequently, material wealth

Temptation vs. Sin: Temptation (the wrong ideas that come to you) is not sin; sin occurs when you yield to those ideas.

Satan's Strategy: The devil targets your weak spots, which are your most vulnerable areas.

Weapons of Defence: You must never answer the Devil with your own wisdom; your only safe ground and weapon is Scripture.

Idleness and Sin: Idleness is the first open door you give to the devil. Furthermore, sin begins as a thought

is entertained as a guest, gains entry into your life, and ultimately becomes your master, leading to unimaginable actions. The instruction is to stop sin in the realm of thought.

• Spiritual Death: If your actions are not guided and determined by the Word of God, those actions are considered "dead works" (2 Peter 2:19), indicating

spiritual stagnation.

True riches are not the money in your bank, but the things God gives you: your values, your relationship with God, and the weight (blessings) you carry in the spirit.

worst form of empowerment is money. If someone wants to empower you truly, they give you ideas, relationships, training, and teaching. If they only give you money without teaching you, they seek to keep you in slavery.

God gives you ideas and enables you to see what others cannot see. This is the capital that makes you rich. When you possess dreams and values, material things can be lost, and you still have the means to replicate them. Anything you have but cannot willingly give away is your limitation—it is bigger than you.

To bring spiritual blessings into physical reality, two

to bring spiritual blessings into physical reality, two things are necessary: Consecration and Conversion.

Consecration: Living for God will make you wealthy (Genesis 30:27). If you don't know the value of your relationship with God, you risk selling it.

Conversion of Blessing: When blessings are pronounced in the spiritual realm, you carry intangible "weight in the spiritual Tou must know how to convert this to the physical. The extent to whi<mark>ch you are multiplying</mark> materially is the extent to which you are working in the spiritual blessings you have received.

Believing God is the foundation for getting wealth, and this is synonymous with becoming genuinely Born Again (1 Kings 3:3-14, 2 Chronicles 20:20).

True and lasting riches flow from consecration to God and a deep understanding that spiritual capital precedes material manifestation. Your salvation is the greatest asset you have.

"You must remember the Lord your God, for He is the One who gives the ability to get wealth". (Deuteronomy 8:17-18*).

This Scripture is an essential reminder because it is very easy, and the natural human tendency is to forget God when you have made it. This false confidence may arise from the belief that you made it because you are smart, worked hard, or are better than others. This is a dangerous route that leads to pride.

Also, if you are not careful, your commitment and zeal for God and the things of God will begin to wane. Whenever you catch yourself on this path, know that you are on the brink of a great fall. God is the Maker of every believer.
