SERMON SUMMARIES

1ST SERVICE: - BUILDING ON A NEW FOUNDATION (Part 4 - Continued from Wednesday, July 3.

Deliverance is not merely about casting out the devil; it also involves filling the delivered. Deliverance is incomplete without discipleship, and no one ever outgrows the need for discipleship.

We have been exploring ways to build new foundations. So far, we have covered four of the ten ways. Let us continue with the next:

5. The Law of Serving (Luke 8:1-3)

After God delivers you, your response should be to serve Him. If you don't serve God, you will end up serving Satan. Genuine service to God can break negative patterns in your lineage (Genesis 34:25; 49:5-7; Exodus 32:22-27). How do we serve God? By offering our time, talents, and treasures wholeheartedly.

6. The Law of Growth

Never allow Satan to find you stuck where he last encountered you (Proverbs 4:18; Luke 4:1,14). Many believers experience stagnation, but this can be overcome through spiritual disciplines such as daily quiet time and consistent service. To grow spiritually, we must feed on God's Word (1 Peter 2:2; 2 Peter 3:18).

There is a season of training and a season of obscurity—times when no one sees your progress. God calls us to be kings and priests, and the first duty of a priest is to gain knowledge. Growth requires consistency, and God trusts only those who remain faithful over time.

2ND SERVICE: BUILDING ON A NEW FOUNDATION (Part 2)

7. The Law of Walking in the Spirit (Isaiah 63:14; Jeremiah 29:11)

- When led by the Holy Spirit, He will guide you to the right place.
- As James 4:7 says, submission to the Holy Spirit makes resisting the devil less burdensome.

8. The Law of Spiritual Warfare

Life is not a carnival; it is a battlefield. The price of liberty is eternal vigilance. We are not fighting to gain victory but to maintain it. How do we fight?

- By the blood of Jesus through Holy Communion (Revelation 12:11)
- With our testimonies (Revelation 12:11)
- By praising God, for the praises of God's people are His throne (Numbers 23:21)
- Through worship, which begins with thanking God for His deeds (1 Samuel 16:23)
- By declaring the Word of God as our sword (Ephesians 6:17)

9. The Law of Sacrifice (Genesis 8:1; 2 Kings 3)

The spiritual realm is governed by sacrifice. Obedience to God matters deeply and often requires sacrifice.

10. The Law of Spiritual Covering (Hosea 12:13)

The person God used to bring you out of bondage is the same one He will use to bring you into your destiny (2 Chronicles 20:20).

DAILY DEVOTIONAL

One of the chief advantages of spiritual things is knowing when to do as the occasion demands. There is a time to be a lamb and a time to be a lion. There is a time to seek peace and a time to wage war. There is a time to be quiet and a time to be vociferous. There is a time to be weak and a time to be strong. (Ecclesiastes 3:1-8).

In Joel 3:10, God commanded His people to hammer their ploughshares into swords and pruning hooks into spears: "Beat your ploughshares into swords, and your pruning hooks into spears: let the weak say, I am strong". Plough and pruning hooks are agricultural instruments for harvest and husbandry, while swords and spears are weapons of war.

Of course, these weapons are spiritual because our real enemies are spiritual (Ephesians 6:12). In Scripture, Joel 3:10, God tells His people to prepare for battle, as it was not time for harvest but for war, and even the weak among them should declare that they are strong.

There is a time when you are not permitted to remain weak or neutral because of what is at stake; to give excuses or to stay weak or neutral is an abomination.

USE YOUR YOUTH WELL

'The glory of youth is their strength...' (Proverbs 20:29)

There is no period in life comparable to the age of youth. It is the noon of life. At noon, the sun is normally at its full strength. The age of youth is like that also.

One remarkable thing about the age of youth is strength. The youth have strength - they are very strong. This is why at the age of youth, most will engage in energetic activities like dancing, sports and other peer-related activities. This strength is not only physical, but also mental. At this age, there is an urge to explore, to experience things and life. There is a restlessness. Strength looking for outlets, adventures and risks.

If you are young, a youth, don't misuse your strength. It is your time to maximize your life. Don't waste your strength on what will not last. Use it wisely, to build for the future. Invest it, don't fritter it away. Many adults who are struggling today made their mistakes during their youthful age. Learn from it.

The best way to maximize your youthful age is to take God's counsel to youths in Ecclesiastes 12:1 - 'Remember (thoughtfully) also your Creator in the days of your youth (for you are not your own, but His) before the evil days come or the years draw near...'

Do you know that almost everyone God used in the Bible, He started with them in their youth? God is looking for those He will use in various spheres of influence - in arts and entertainment, in business, in science and tech, in education, just name it.

Be that person, that youth, that God can use. Remember Him. Serve sincerely with your youth. Use all your strength for Him and watch Him make you great.
