SERMON SUMMARY: RULES OF MANIFESTATION (1-3)

Preserving What You Gathered during Fasting

After a period of fasting and prayers, the following action will be to manifest all that God has pronounced concerning you. To do this, you must start by preserving all that you gathered during the time of separation.

To gather, you must make (1) attending church a priority and (2) studying the bible a lifestyle. Every person has a Mission Statement from scripture. The only place one can find God's purpose is His Word. There is a Scripture meant for me to fulfill!

How To Preserve What You've Gathered

1. Find out the things that God has spoken concerning you in Scripture. (Matthew 7:24, 2 Peter 1:20, Luke 21:15).
2. Proclaim what you have found out. Proclamation precedes manifestation. (Matthew 12:36-37).
3. Manifesting new things and God's power. You boldly declare that Jesus is the reason and answer.
4. Don't be carried away by the flattery of men. It is the trap of the devil.
5. Be ready for envy and opposition/adversaries.

7 Things that Preserve & Help You Manifest What God Gives You:

1. Never despise the one through whom God blesses you: how you get a thing is how you sustain/preserve it. (Hosea 12:13, 1 Timothy 5:17, Jeremiah 3:15-16, 1 Corinthians 9:1).
2. Do not sleep, or the enemy will sweep in and seize. Always protect what God has given you. (Matthew 13:25).
3. Nurture what you have conceived, or else it dies. You nurture by feeding your spirit by the Word of God. (Matthew 4:4).
4. Ensure your heart (spirit man) is protected.
5. Don't mix the pure with the polluted (John 15:3, Leviticus 19:19, Isaiah 28:22).
6. Be on the offensive. Power is for action. Take charge.
7. Take responsibility. Until you take responsibility, you will not see the manifestation of God's promises. (Isaiah 17:32)

God revives, restores, and heals us quickly and in His sight so we can live and dwell in His presence and be near Him. God is after a love that lasts and not religion.

God wants more intimacy with you—Yadah is the intimate knowledge of God (1 Corinthians 7:1).

Benefits of Knowing God:

- The more you know God, the more you will crave Him. The knowledge of God does not have a limit. (Psalms 63:1, 42:1-2).
- The more you know God, the more you resemble Him and do things like Him.
- The more you know God, the more you become and behave like Him. (Genesis 1:26).
- The more you know God personally, the more you will manifest Him personally. (1 Peter 2:9-10).
- The more you know God personally, the stronger you become spiritually, mentally, physically, financially, etc. (Daniels 11:32).
- The more you know God personally, the more of His life you receive, have, and manifest.
- Your personal pursuit of the knowledge of God shows that you love God. (Hosea 4:1, 5-6).

How to Know God:

- Partake and Participate in every Church Service.
- Repeatedly listen to the Word of God.
- Meditate on the Word of God you write down.
- Don't miss your personal praying time.
- Take Discipleship classes.
- Join a Spiritual Group in Church. Do not isolate yourself.

ENCOUNTERS in HERMON

'And they overcame him by the blood of the
Lamb and the word of their testimony....'

(Revelation 12:11)

My first testimony is on how God transformed me from eating hand to mouth to being a capable man. I came to Lagos July of 2022, and life became instantly very difficult for me, before coming I had secured a job that comes with accommodation but on my arrival to Lagos, for reasons which I don't understand till date the company didn't take me. Things became tough for me. I had no accommodation and couldn't feed myself. It was very tough. The closest thing to family I had was my friend, Nkemjika (who then used to worship in HERMON). I did a lot of menial jobs to survive and slept where I found, mostly in security houses where I worked.

My friends, Nkemjika and Progress, were very helpful. I used to also call my mom, a widow, to send money to me to feed. She lives in Rivers State. A thing I consider most shameful since I was to be the one catering for her. I didn't have much of a choice.

It was about September 2022 that my friend, Nkemjika, invited me to Hermon Christian Centre. As I continued coming, I secured a job that was better than all other jobs have done here in Lagos. It wasn't the best job because even looking at my life now sometimes I wonder I how was able to survive the job. But then I was happy doing it because it was the best I had then. I later got another job which I was to resume on 4th of January 2023. I was very excited about this new job because to me it was the best job (at least that was what I thought as of then).

However, during the Cross Over service (December 2022), the senior Pastor said something when we were about to pray - that whatever we planned for the new year 2023, we should put them aside and let God take control and that we should give God permission to make our plans for us and go with God's plan. After hearing this, I was reluctant to pray that prayer... because I had already planned how my 2023 would be better with this new job I was to resume on January 4th which I thought was the best job at that time. But something inside of me told me to do as the man of God had said. I obeyed. I prayed that prayer with the whole of my heart and let God take control.

As expected I resumed the job on January 4th, but by January 9th, I was sacked for a very flimsy reason. This was the first time in my life I have ever been sacked. I felt so bad and thought that I was under a curse or my village people have followed me to Lagos. But while I was feeling sorry for myself, I heard that same voice that compelled me to pray the way pastor had asked us during the Cross Over service asking me why I was angry. Was I not the one who prayed that God should scatter our own plans so that His plan should be?

After hearing that voice I had hope again, so I contacted the agent that got me the job and told him what had happened. He asked me to come the following day and when I came, he sent me to another interview and I got the job. I was asked to resume the next day. On my way out of the place, at the gate of the company, I heard that voice again saying, "God don start oh ... just wait make u see how this job go turn out to be." And the job turned out exactly as I heard - better in pay, less stressful and less demanding.

I was very happy that I listened to the pastor and prayed as he had asked us to do because that job I thought was the best job then was not God's best for me then. God had something far better. This job also came with accommodation. I started feeling like a man again because I can feed myself from my own pocket, I stopped calling mom for money instead I was sending the little I could then. I could now afford to buy new clothes for myself once in a while, something I never thought possible in my first seven months in Lagos. This is because most of the clothes I was wearing then was Nkemjika's clothes. But now, I can buy for myself.

The only issue I had with this job was that I couldn't attend church physically because of the distance. I prefer onsite worship to online experience. I also worked on Sundays. I was seriously missing church, especially Pastor's sermons. I will just be hearing pastor's voice in my head. How he teaches the word of God bit by bit, word for word etc... It was at that point I started praying that God should make it possible for me to be attending church again. It became my earnest and regular prayer.

Pastor had also taught us that it is not good to move from one job to another, even if the work environment is unpleasant, without first consulting God. I kept praying and believing God for a solution. I asked God to show me sign if it is His will for me to change jobs. He gave that sign and I contacted my job agent for a new job while I kept working diligently as Pastor taught us.

The agent got back to me sooner than expected. He begged and insisted. I should go for it. The salary was twice my present salary and it offered other perks. Again, I asked the Lord and He gave me a sign to go. I went for the interview and was told to resume next day. But I declined as I wanted to leave my present company honorably as we have been taught.

was very grateful to God for this new job, but my desire to attend physical services did not abate. I used to work on Sundays. I kept praying and trusting God. On the 4th of November 2023, something happened at my job that made me to accept an offer to replace my friend, Nkemjika, who was relocating to Canada.

Even though his boss had employed another person to replace, I believed God for the job because it was close to church and had better pay, learning opportunities and exposure. I got the job as the person who was employed to replace my friend just stopped coming. God answered me. I got the job and have been coming physically to church. My life has gone from glory to glory.

Also I remember that during that 2022 Cross Over, Pastor had asked that we do two things: take a screenshot of our bank account balance and a selfie because God will so change our story. I am glad to testify that this is my testimony. God has so changed my life that even I, cannot recognize myself and my bank account has increased beyond my wildest imagination. I am a living testimony. I had also testified of how I anointed myself daily before leaving the house as instructed by Pastor during January 2024 Anointing Service. While doing this, I made a mysterious discovery. I found that inside my bottle of the anointing oil, an egg! Since this incident, my life has been from glory to glory.

I want to share this because I have learned that whenever Pastor asks you to do something, please do it because you must see the results, I mean I am a living testimony.

During the surprise celebration of Pastor's birthday last Sunday, I just kept saying to myself that even if Pastor tells me to be keeping my hand on top of my head everyday, I will just do it. I assure that if you do it, you will definitely see results one day. I am talking from experience.

I also want to use this opportunity to say thank you to Pastor for being an amazing pastor to me and to many other people. I pray that God will continue to bless him and keep him for us in the name of Jesus. Amen.
