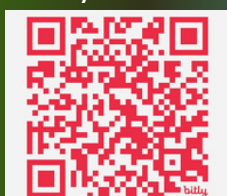
Your mouth speaks what overflows from your heart. And what you say is what you shall have.

SERMON SUMMARIES

1ST SERVICE: LIVING AS APPOINTED (Part 1)

There is a way God has appointed for His children to live and a way Satan has appointed. It depends on who your God is. Like responsible parents, God has a plan for how you should live. God's will is for us to live as He lives and do as He does. Biblical faith means imitating God.

God disapproves of irresponsibility (1 Timothy 5:8). You must have a plan, a vision, and a standard. The reason many struggle is a lack of vision. Anywhere there is vision, there will be provision. The most intelligent people tie their vision to God's needs, like Hannah did. The best place to get vision is from God's Word.

Romans 10:12-14 tells us God is rich to everyone who calls on Him. Whoever calls on the Name of the Lord shall be saved and delivered from all troubles. 1 Peter 1:3-4 reveals that God has given us new birth to a living hope. When Adam fell from glory, all of us fell from glory to shame. In Christ Jesus, God brought us back to His glory.

Hope is an earnest expectation that good will come. If you are God's child, you should not be depressed. Christianity is about hope. Your most dominant thought will govern your life. Proverbs 4:18 says God plans for today to be better than yesterday. Your life should be from glory to glory, not ups and downs.

When you change your mindset, everything falls into place to align with it. When Joseph was imprisoned after doing good, that was God's plan to get him to the palace. In every situation, find something good to focus on—that is your way of escape. There is no demotion for any child of God. All things work for your good. God's will is greater than your comfort.

If what you're believing God for hasn't happened, you need to grow in the spirit. 1 Peter 1:3-7 shows that every trial is shorter than the promise. We prolong trials by murmuring and questioning God. Your faith must be tested. Gold must be refined by fire to become pure. Any untried faith is fake. When things aren't going right, stay in thanksgiving. Trials build capacity in you. James 1:2-4 teaches that trials produce the patience needed for maturity. Only mature people get the inheritance (Galatians 4:1-2).

We stumble in tests when we lose the joy of God's Word. God's Word should intoxicate you and numb the pain until you overcome. That Word brings joy, hope, and strength. Stay with that Word and use it to create a faith environment.

You can hasten or delay God's promise. Israel delayed God's promise through unbelief. According to 2 Peter 3:12, what you confidently expect, you will hasten. When you focus on God's Word and live according to it, you hasten its appearance. Keep hearing that Word until it intoxicates you, establishes hope, and hastens the manifestation of God's promises.

Bottom Line: God has an appointed way for you to live. You've been restored to living hope. Your thoughts govern your life—focus on good. Trials refine faith and build the maturity needed for inheritance. Stay thankful, let God's Word intoxicate you, and hasten His promises through confident expectation.

2ND SERVICE: LIVING AS APPOINTED (2)

Divine Royalty Training

God has appointed a way for His children to live. Royals undergo peculiar training—how they speak, dress, and act is different. 1 Peter 2:9 declares we are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood. Every Church service is training in divine royalty, teaching us how to live and reminding us of who we are and what to expect.

We attract what we think about most. The more you recognise something, the more it gravitates to you. Every service deposit in your heavenly account, so when you pray, you can withdraw from it. Some are attempting to withdraw without making any deposits. When born again, you're not ordinary—you've been born into the lineage of God, the King of Kings.

Heavenly Citizenship and Angels

1 Corinthians 2:9-10 teaches that God has in store what eyes haven't seen and ears haven't heard. This comes by revelation, which is why we attend church. When you have a mountain before you, command it to move. If you don't doubt but believe, the mountain will move.

1 Peter 1:3-4 reveals an inheritance reserved in heaven for us. When we got born again, we became citizens of heaven (Philippians 3:20). We live according to Heaven's economy and security—no scarcity or sickness in Heaven.

Angels are heaven's ministers waiting for you to speak God's Word. Hebrews 1:14 teaches that angels are ministering spirits sent for those who inherit salvation. When you don't know what's written or that angels exist, you severely limit yourself. Angels respond to God's Word. Many aren't speaking because they're not growing.

Conditions: The Word of Grace

You need to grow in the spirit to access your inheritance. Not growing is why many prayers aren't answered. Acts 20:32 reveals three key Words: the Word of His Grace, the Word of Faith, and the Word of the Kingdom. The Word of Grace builds you up and gives you an inheritance. Only at maturity can you activate the blessing.

Hebrews 13:9 warns that many have been led astray by strange doctrines. Only the Word of Grace establishes you—what Jesus has done for you. You must be established in knowing God gave Jesus for you, and if He didn't withhold Jesus, He'll provide you with everything. When your heart is established in the Word of Grace, it builds you up, and at maturity, your inheritance is delivered.

Spiritual Hunger

One sign you're born again is spiritual hunger for His Word. If you don't have it, you're in danger. 1 Peter 2:2 teaches: desire the sincere milk of the word. If missing preaching doesn't hurt you, something is wrong. You need nourishment by the Word.

Bottom Line: You are divine royalty, a citizen of heaven with angels assigned to you. Every Church service makes deposits in your heavenly account and renews your mind to who you are. You can't access your inheritance until you mature spiritually through the Word of Grace—what Jesus has done for you. Spiritual hunger for God's Word is the proof you're truly born again. Attend Church, speak God's Word to activate angelic ministry, and let the Word of Grace establish and build you up to maturity where your inheritance is released.

MIDWEEK SERVICE: GROWING IN GRACE

God has an inheritance reserved in heaven for us (1 Peter 1:3-4). We have no reason for depression because God gave us living hope—earnest expectation of good. However, Galatians 4:1-2 teaches that as long as you remain a child in the spirit, you can't access the inheritance. You must grow in the spirit through God's Word.

1 Peter 2:2 shows that desiring God's Word is a sign you're genuinely born again. Hebrews 5:12 teaches that God's Word has milk and strong meat. Staying on milk means you won't receive an inheritance.

Three Stages of Growth

2 Peter 3:18 commands us to grow in Grace and knowledge of Jesus. Grace multiplies as you know God more—hearing, doing, and obeying His Word (2 Peter 1:2).

1. Grow in the Word—increase in knowledge.
2. Wax strong in the spirit—proof of growing in grace.
3. Wisdom—the highest height of grace that enables mighty works.

The Word has milk (nourishment), water (cleansing—Ephesians 5:26), and wine (intoxication). Every time you sit under God's Word, it cleanses you spiritually. This is why we leave sermons playing—they sanctify the atmosphere.

Jesus' first miracle was turning water into wine. The Word must become wine that intoxicates you to do the impossible. Abraham, Moses, and the Hebrews 11 heroes were intoxicated with God's Word. Turn water into wine by meditating until it gets implanted in you. Don't stay in milk—get to the Wine by brooding on the Word until it roots in you.

Bottom Line: You can't access your inheritance while spiritually immature. Grow through God's Word in three stages: knowledge → spirit strength → wisdom. Move beyond milk to wine—meditate on God's Word until it intoxicates you to do the impossible and activate a breakthrough.
