SERMON SUMMARIES

1ST SERVICE: - SUPERNATURAL FAVOUR

Favour is very powerful. Without it, you can't fulfil destiny. After God delivers us, He grants us favour. The purpose of favour is to recover what has been stolen from us and what has been lost.

THE PURPOSE OF FAVOUR

God granted them that favour for specific reasons which apply to us today:

- 1. To build God a house and extend His kingdom**
 - Refer to Exodus 12:1-8
 - Matthew 6:33 tells us to seek the Kingdom of God first.
 - Zechariah 1:17 teaches that the Kingdom of God expands through prosperity.
 - God blesses us so His Kingdom will prosper. The danger in not giving offerings from what He blesses us with is that we risk idolising material things.
- 2. To be responsible for our children**
 - Exodus 3:22
 - 1 Timothy 5:8 states that whoever does not provide for his household is worse than an infidel and has denied the faith.
 - God wants us to cater to our families' needs rather than outsourcing responsibility.
- 3. To live responsibly**
 - Deuteronomy 2:5-8
 - We must learn to live within our means and not borrow excessively.
 - By giving 10% of our income to God, He teaches us to plan our expenses in percentages.

2ND SERVICE: - SUPERNATURAL FAVOUR (Part 2)

OBSTACLES TO FAVOUR

It is very possible that our favour can be sabotaged through spiritual manipulation (Isaiah 25:7). In the book of Esther, Mordecai discovered that two of the king's guards had planned to assassinate him (Esther 2:21-23).

Although this was reported and recorded, no action was taken for Mordecai (Esther 3:1-6). Instead, Haman was promoted (Esther 3:1-6).

Haman was very evil and planned to eliminate all the Jews (Esther 3:7-15). But God, through Esther, intervened after prayers were made (Esther 4:15-17).

OUR ROLE IN MAINTAINING FAVOUR

If we don't fight for what God has given us, the enemy will steal God's favour. If we stay passive, even God will not act on our behalf.

The Bible says whatever we bind on earth will be bound in Heaven, and whatever we loose on earth will be loosed in Heaven (Matthew 18:18).

Remember, the kingdom of God suffers violence and only the violent take it by force (Matthew 11:12). Be aggressive in prayer so that the enemy, through spiritual manipulation, will not be able to steal your favour.

MIDWEEK SERVICE: THE SHIELD OF FAVOUR

Psalm 5:12 shows that favour is a blessing from the Lord. Two things we can deduce from the passage: it is a blessing from God and a shield for the righteous. If you don't have favour, you can be easily attacked.

Favour does 3 things:

1. Favour shields the righteous.
2. It distinguishes the righteous.
3. It attracts the goodwill and support of other people.

Nobody can fulfil destiny without the favour of God. According to the Hebrew translation of the Bible, there are 12 different kinds of favour which are classed into 9 significant types:

1. Charismatic Favour
2. Compassionate Favour
3. Credential Favour
4. Preferential Favour
5. Practical Favour
6. Associate Favour
7. Conferred Favour
8. Covenant Favour
9. Sovereign or Supernatural Favour

God always prepares a table for His own. When the Lord Jesus rose from the dead, He went to meet Peter and the other six apostles who had gone fishing. They had fished all night and caught nothing.

Then, as the day was about to break, they heard a voice, "Children, have you any meat?" They answered, "No". Then, He told them to cast the net on the right side, and a multitude of fish came. (John 21:1-6).
