SERMON SUMMARY: THE LAWS OF SPIRITUAL SIGHT

How you think matters. Your perspective about a matter or situation can limit God's move in your life. After we are born again and receive the Holy Spirit, God renews our minds. (Romans 12:2). God can't do wonders in and through you until you agree with Him (Amos 3:3), so the first thing He does is to renew

Whenever you're going through a challenge, and you see things from God's perspective, even though the challenge is still there, it changes how you see that challenge. You understand that that challenge allows God to showcase His might and wonder.

So, how do we renew our minds? The Word of God renews our minds. As we look into the mirror of God's Word, we get transformed into the likeness of Christ. (2 Corinthians 3:18). We can overcome sin and temptations by hiding God's Word in our hearts (Psalms 119:9-11).

If the Word of God is not in your mouth, it's not in your heart. The most significant impediment to a believer is darkness - ignorance. Jesus said in Matthew 6:22-23 that if the eyes are not good, there will be darkness. And if the light in you is darkness, how great is that darkness. So, what makes the way we see good? When we see the way God sees.

For you to see the way God sees, there are certain principles that we must know from Mark 8:22-26.

First, Jesus took the blind man by the hand, signifying that we must have a relationship with Him and be in fellowship with Him. Then Jesus led the blind man out of the city, signifying separation. The second principle is that God will separate you for consecration. separation could mean separation from friends that drain your faith or environments (family, location, etc) (2 Corinthians 6:17).

After this, Jesus spat in the eyes of the blind man twice so he could see clearly. The first time, the blind said he saw men as trees, but the second time, he saw clearly. The third principle from here is that renewing the mind takes time. It's not instantaneous; it's a gradual process. But as long as we consistently read, meditate, and obey God's Word, our minds will keep being renewed.

Finally, Jesus told the blind man not to return to his hometown. The principle here is this: many miracles are aborted because we are too hasty to announce them. Sometimes, God enlightens us, but instead of waiting and brooding on it until it becomes flesh in us, we hastily announce it to the world. We must be wise to keep specific insights away from the world.

REPROGRAMMING YOUR LIFE WITH GOD'S WORD: (Midweek Service)

We reprogram our lives with the Word of God as we love and do everything written therein (Psalm 107:20). Whenever God wants to reprogram our lives or change our trajectory, He pours His Spirit in us, not the situation we are in. (Isaiah 32:15). As the Spirit of God works in our lives, our circumstances will begin to change.

Three distinctive things happen when we are focused on God's Word: we will live long, our children will also live long, and our days will be like heaven on earth.

There are 3 gates to get God's Word into our lives: our ears (Proverbs 4:20), our eyes (Proverbs 4:21), and our hearts (Proverbs 4:21). You become what you constantly behold. The Bible says that as a man thinks in his heart, so is he. (Proverbs 23:7).

So, to reprogram our lives with God's Word and see the manifestation of the Word and the Spirit in our lives, we must constantly listen, look into, and hide the Word of God in our hearts by thinking about it.

Zacchaeus was rich but so desperate to see the Lord Jesus that he did what few people in his class would ever do. "Because he was a man of little stature, he ran ahead of the crowd and climbed a sycamore tree in order to see the Lord Jesus." (Luke 19:1-4).

As the Lord Jesus, thronged by the multitude, passed the road, He saw Zacchaeus on that sycamore tree. You see, Zacchaeus' plan was just to see the Lord, but rather, the Lord saw him up on that sycamore tree and said to him, "Zacchaeus, make haste, and come down; for today, I must abide at your house." (Luke 19:5).

The tables turned in the favour of Zacchaeus. What many were struggling for, he got by grace. He had only just wanted to see the Lord, but now the Lord saw him and was even going to dine with him.




