## SERMON SUMMARIES

1ST SERVICE: - PROVOKING THE FAVOUR OF GOD

We have established that we can not fulfil destiny without favour. Favour is very important if we want to go far in life, and there are certain things that when we do, we get

However, some principles naturally procure favour. It's not a matter of provoking; it just comes naturally because of what we do. When we are diligent at work, we naturally procure favour (Proverbs 12:24). As believers, we work hard not to make money; we work so that our innate gifts can be harnessed into skill.

Another thing that naturally gives us favour is being in the presence of God (Exodus 23:27).

Now, while there are some things we do that naturally bring favour, some other things we can do will provoke God's favour upon our lives. These include:

<u>Hearkening to Counsel:</u> This involves listening to obey, not listening to argue. (1 Kings 12:6-11, 1 Kings 4:1-6). Esther 2:10 and 2:15).

The Bible, speaking about Jesus in Isaiah 11:2, mentioned the characteristics of the Spirit that was upon Him. One of the things mentioned is the "Spirit of Counsel and Might." This tells us that we cannot demonstrate might until we have hearkened to counsel.

In Proverbs 11:14, the Bible tells us that in the multitude of counsel, there's safety. However, we must ask God for discernment so that we don't take wrong counsel from anyone, young or old.

2ND SERVICE: - PROVOKING THE FAVOUR OF GOD

Good Understanding: (Proverbs 3:13-18). Have you seen students who demonstrate a deep understanding of a subject? The teacher/lecturer who teaches that subject/course naturally gravitates towards that student.

Having understanding and insight into any matter will make favour to follow us.

Excellence: Excellence is not perfection; it's giving whatever tasks you're given your best. There are three primary ways we can demonstrate excellence: excellence in our work (Daniel 1:8-20), in our appearance (Genesis 41:14), and in our space and how we organise ourselves (1 Kings 10:4-5; 1 Corinthians 14:40).

Diligence brings us before kings, but excellence gives us a seat with kings.

<u>Living a Consecrated Life to God</u>: This means deciding to live in a way that pleases God.

Daniel and his friends refused to defile themselves by eating food sacrificed to other gods, and God rewarded them for it (Daniel 1:8-17; 2 Timothy 2:19-21).

<u>Living in Unity:</u> (Psalm 133:1-3). It is where God sees unity that He commands His blessings. (Acts 2:1-4). The beginning of disunity is murmuring (Philippians 2:14). (Acts 6:1-7). (Genesis 13:8-9). We must never forget that a house divided against itself cannot stand (Mark 3:25). MIDWEEK SERVICE: PROVOKING THE FAVOUR

- <u>Fasting and Praying</u>: The first reason for fasting is to humble ourselves before God (Isaiah 55:6-7). This is our responsibility. We can't come before God as if we know it all or have it all. (Esther 4:15-17). (1 Kings 21:27-29).
- Prompt and Complete Obedience: (Genesis 22:1-19). Delayed obedience is also disobedience. Half obedience is also disobedience. (1 Samuel 15:22-23; 16:13). (1 Samuel 15:22).

How you obey God and when you obey God matter. Obedience postponed is a blessing delayed. Every obedience results in blessings and favour.

The proof that you trust God is that you do what he says wholly and promptly. Faith is the outworking of your trust. Hebrews 11 vs 6,

How do I know that the presence of God is with me and I am being led by God? You may ask? God Himself answered when He assured Moses that His presence would go with him: 'And He said, 'My presence shall go with you, and I will give you rest.' (Exodus 33:14). The proof of divine presence and divine leading is that you have rest.

Many people interpret Rest in several ways, but the key thing about resting in God is that you cease from your labours, wisdom, and desires (the very things that took away your peace). To cease from your labours does not mean that you sit there and do nothing, but that you believe and embrace what God has done and start living according to it.

God said that He has finished the works from the foundations of the earth. [Hebrews 4:3]. Rest is earnestly seeking what God has done and living according to it. All that God has done is written in the Bible. If you are not living according to the Word of God, you cannot have this type of

The door to this kind of rest is the Lord Jesus Christ. 'He said, "Come unto Me, all that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest." (Matthew 11:28-30).



**MAXIMIZE THIS SEASON - WORK** 

One of the things that should stand out for you from the sermon of last Sunday is the importance of work.

It is through work that we turn our raw potentials of gift and talent into skill. Like you heard, the market pays for skill not for gifts or talents. Even if you earn through your gifts or talents, you will not be able to command the best rates or a premium.

Your gift or talent needs to be processed. Take for example, crude oil. In its raw state, it commands little yield but when processed by refining, many other valuable petro-chemical derivatives are produced. In its crude state, it is like \$40 per barrel. But after going through the refining process, that single barrel can yield products worth thousands of dollars.

The more you work, the more refined your talent or gift and the more value you will command.

Find work in your area of gifting or talent. Volunteer if you have to. If you can't find any work along those lines, do whatever that is legitimate your hands find to do and do it well. Soon enough, the right doors will open.

Don't loiter around or squander valuable time on social media and entertainment. Use that time to learn a skill online, start an online course or something. If you are seeking to improve, vast resources abound online. Make use of them. Don't just entertain yourself, educate yourself.

One day, everything will compound and come together. Rome was not built in a day. Neither did God create the whole earth in a day. It took Him six days of work to make the earth. If God worked six days, why do you think you will succeed working for less. Every good thing you see took time and work. Go do likewise.
